

Announcement Vacancies

Phetchaburi Rajabhat University, Phetchaburi, Thailand

Applications are invited for the following vacant posts at the International Tourism and Service Industry Program, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Phetchaburi Rajabhat University, Thailand, to be on a fixed contract basis.

1. Teaching positions

Two foreign national lecturers in English; academic backgrounds in tourism, the hotel industry, hospitality or service industry are not necessary.

2. Salary and conditions of service.

A starting salary as specified by the university is as follows:

Doctoral degree

38,300 Baht per month

Master's degree

35,750 Baht per month

Bachelor's degree

29,100 Baht per month

(An additional accommodation rental fee of 5,000 Baht per month is also payable.)

3. Job Description:

3.1 To deliver lectures and professional training to undergraduate students. To undertake research. To provide counseling and advice to students as found necessary. To give academic services to the local society (i.e.): preserving arts and culture, academic article writing, performing academic works and undertaking other tasks as may be assigned from time to time.

3.2 To make available academic teaching or professional advice in various fields as assigned, conduct academic research, advise students in academic matters and student activities, provide academic services to society, preserve arts and culture and perform other related duties following the principles of morality, ethics and professional standards and complete workload standards as specified by the university.

4. General qualifications and specific qualifications required.

4.1 Candidates must not be in violation of the rules, regulations, announcements, or other orders of the university in any way, and never commit any breach of contract against the university.

- 4.2 Candidates for the positions must be qualified for the specific position. Details are attached to this announcement.
- 4.3 Applicants must be graduates and have been approved by the Approval Authority by the closing date for applications.

5. Date, time, and place of application

6. Necessary documents and evidence for the submission of an application

- 6.1 A completed application form.
- 6.2 A copy of the applicant's passport.
- 6.3 A copy of the applicant's work permit. (if presently employed)
- 6.4 A photograph, suitable for use in a passport, without hat or sunglasses which has been taken not more than 6 months ago, size to be at least 1x1 inch, 3 copies.
- 6.5 A copy of the applicant's degree certificate, or a copy of a certificate of completion of a bachelor's degree, master's degree, doctoral degree, 1 copy as appropriate.
- 6.6 Bachelor's degree, master's degree, and doctoral degree thesis, 1 copy as appropriate.
 - 6.7 English test results.
 - 6.8 Certificate of employment.(if appropriate)
 - 6.9 Evidence of payment of application fee. (In case of applying by mail)

7. Examination application fee

Applicants for the competitive examination must pay an application fee of 100 baht. In case of applying for the examination by mail, the applicant must transfer money to the university's account, Government Savings Bank, Chom Klao Bridge Branch, account name, education allowance, Phetchaburi Rajabhat University, account number 0201 26789195, and attach a copy of payment fees proof along with admission documents.

8. Conditions of application

8.1 Applicants are responsible for verifying and certifying themselves as having the general and specific qualifications for the position in accordance with the recruitment notice. Applicants must accurately and completely fill in the details as required in the application form and attach the required documents for the application to be correct and complete as specified in the recruitment announcement. In the event of an error caused by the applicant, for any reason, or, it is found that the qualifications document submitted by the applicant does not match or does not comply with the notification, Phetchaburi Rajabhat University will consider applicants to be disqualified from the beginning of this application, and the application fee will not be refunded.

8.2 It is the applicant's responsibility to follow all the guidance and requirements for the competitive examination of Phetchaburi Rajabhat University.

9. Criteria and methods of competitive examinations

Applicants must take a competency assessment as specified by the university, which is a competitive examination in 3 sections as follows:

- 1) Position-specific knowledge (100 points)
- 2) Teaching Practice Examination on skills in the major (100 points)
- 3) Interview (100 points)

10. Judging Criteria and Announcement of Competitive Exam Results

Those deemed to have passed the competitive examinations must have obtained test scores on the Position-specific competency section, teaching-examination section, practice exams on skills in the major, and the interview section of not less than 60 percent.

11. Announcing the list of candidates for the examination

The university will announce the list of eligible candidates for the examination on Friday, February 20, 2023, on the Website of Phetchaburi Rajabhat University. https://www.pbru.ac.th, titled "News for job applications".

12. Conditions of Appointment

- 12.1 Those that pass the competitive examination and are appointed will have a probationary period of not less than 1 year.
- 12.2 Those who pass the competitive examination on the date of the contract of employment must not currently be a government officer or employee of a government agency, government employee or employee of other state agencies, state enterprises officer or employee of a local government agency.

12.3 Those who pass the competitive examination must enter into an employment contract as specified by Phetchaburi Rajabhat University.

13. Qualifications

For this competitive examination, applicants for the competitive examination must verify and certify in their application that they have the general qualifications and specific qualifications for the position according to the competitive examination announcement. If it appears later that any applicant does not have the qualifications specified in the announcement It shall be deemed that such candidate was not qualified to apply for the examination and is therefore not eligible to be recruited and appointed to the position applied for.
